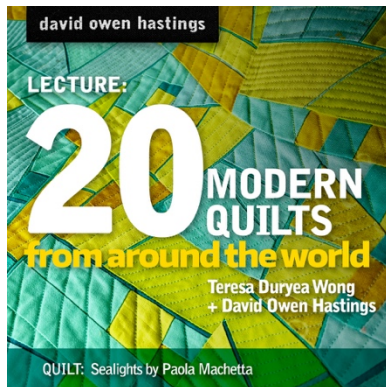


Lecture: 20 Modern Quilts from Around the World
